EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

2020/22 was a special period. COVID-19 has challenged everyone and everywhere. In the past two years, our work has focused on online academic activities and public education seminars and events and achieved gratifying results. Meanwhile, we have kept building and improving the organizational structure,



To achieve our objectives, we developed the Doctor's Column to deliver the acuate and quality information to the Chinese community in Australia. We are looking forward to the new partnership project with Local Health Districts (LHD) and aim to extend our outreach service to those regions as well.

Moving forward, we hope to improve the activities in creating collaborations with professionals and communities. We understand that the long-term sustainability and efficiency of these projects relies upon the pillars of frequent communication and effective cooperation among all of our valued members.

PUBLIC SUPPORT SERVICES

1. Public Education Sessions

The public education sessions were mainly focused on cancer prevention and control awareness, GP's role in cancer screening.

Simultaneous interpretation was available for both Chinese and English-speaking participants. The education sessions were recorded and published in CACA Australia WeChat. With the consent of the guest speakers, the recorded information sessions were uploaded onto the website of CACA Australia.

- Session One: •Cancer and Nutrition The relationship between Chinese eating habits and cancer; held online in November 7, 2020, a total attendance over 500 participants.
- Session Two: TCM Philosophy and Cancer Treatment and Rehabilitation. held online in November 7, 2020, with a total attendance of over 500 participants.
- Session Three: Colorectal Cancer Prevention and Control, held online on May 6, 2021, a total attendance of over 1000 participants.
- Session Four: Breast Cancer Screening and Treatment, held in City of Sydney on October 24, 2021, a total online audience over 20,000.
- Session Five: Understanding liver cancer and treatment, held online on April 30, 2022, a total online audience over 20,000.







- Session Six: Understanding what's difference of early diagnosis and screening of gastrointestinal cancer between Australia and China, held online on April 30, 2022, a total online audience over 20,000.
- Session Seven: Understanding Thyroid cancer, held online on April 30, 2022, a total online audience over 20,000. (Collaboration with China Anti-Cancer Association)
- Session Eight, Lung cancer prevention, treatment and clinical trials in Australia, held online on October 9, 2022, a total online audience over 40,000.
- Session Nine: Why do Asian ladies get lung cancer without smoking? held online on October 9, 2022, a total online audience of over 40,000.
- Session Ten: Targeted therapy for lung cancer. held online on October 9, 2022, a total online audience of over 40,000. (Collaboration with China Anti-Cancer Association)



2. Telephone and Online Support

Emotional and information support was provided over the phone, email, and online chat to 186 clients. A total of 55 phone/email and online chat were made to provide more intensive emotional support and information support.

For examples:


- Are there any new treatment/drugs is for her2 positive of breast cancer?

- How can I find the current information about clinical trials for advanced lung cancer in Australia?
- What are the early symptoms of lung cancer? How to achieve an early diagnosis?
- Are any risks of e-cigarettes for lung cancer?
- Do any way relieve the bone inhibition caused by chemotherapy?

3. Social Media and Doctor's Column

A total of 88 articles through social media channel and Website were published during the year. Those articles provide the latest cancer news, cancer educational information, health promotion; and also provides a platform for sharing the personal experiences of patients and carers. A total of 784 subscribers are on the distribution list. We have created a Doctor's Column to answer public concerned questions, which becomes very popular. The most popular articles have over 5000 readers.









SPECIAL PROGAMS

The special professional program is a major activity in CACA Australia and continues to be supported as an important service to the members.

 GP Special Training Program: Colorectal Cancer Screening and Control - jointly hosted by Australia Chinese Doctor Society

On April 22, 2021, successfully held online training program for GP with 35 attendances.

2. Sino-Australia Symposium on Cancer Care - jointly hosted by CACA and Icon group.

On November 25, 2020, the 1st Sino-Australia Symposium on Cancer Care was successfully held at the Guangzhou Convention Center in China and was live broadcasting with over 35,000 online audience. The symposium brings together experts from China and Australia to discuss and share the latest progress on cancer care both in China and Australia. The 8 professional speakers have presented their research and achievement about cancer prevention, treatment and clinical trials etc.

On November 20, 2022, the 2nd Sino-Australia Symposium on Cancer Care was successfully held at Hangzhou Convention Center in China and was live broadcasting with over 50000 online audience.

The symposium brings together experts from China and Australia to discuss and share the latest progress on cancer care both in China and Australia. Session I features on current Progress of Cancer Precision Prevention and Control. Speakers will present clinical practice and research findings on various topics including precision prevention of gastric cancer, lung cancer mortality factors, prognostic factors and multidisciplinary treatment modalities for colorectal cancer. Session II features on current progress of cancer integrating treatment. Speakers will exchange the latest research on pan-cancerassociated long noncoding RNA, microbiome, post-treatment surveillance strategy for low case. The theme of Session III is applied innovation training cancer care professionals.)









FUNDRAISING EVENTS

From 2021, our organization has settled October as **Cancer Awareness & Education Month**. We have started to organize free public education seminars and physical excises complied with fundraising. Do it for cancer!

1. Walking for Breast Healthy - the first fundraising event has been held in Chinese Communities in October 2021. There were 42 participants and raised over 3000 dollars to promote breast cancer awareness.





2. Care Your Lung Walk Along - a fundraising event has been held in October 2022. There are 36 participants and raised over 2700 dollars to support lung cancer education.





VOLUNTEER MANAGEMENT

A total of 30 volunteers have been recruited during the period. They were assigned to different roles based on their interests and skills assessment.
